**Present, But Not Voting**

*Got this off the Internet, but there weren't any notes for credit.*

In the late 1800s, wealthy English philanthropist, Jeremy Bentham, left a fortune to a London hospital with one odd condition attached to his will. The hospital could keep the money so long as Bentham was present at every board meeting. So for over 100 years, the remains of Jeremy Bentham were wheeled into the boardroom every month and placed at the head of the table. And for over 100 years, the minutes of every board meeting included this line, "Mr. **Jeremy Bentham, present but not voting.**"

It's sad that some view the church in that manner—**present, but not participating.** They join the church by profession of faith or church transfer, or through Confirmation and then after a while, you never see them. They are satisfied to be **present (on the church roll) but not participating.**

Now, it's important that they are part of the church because that means that at some point at some church, they made a profession of faith and answered serious faith questions. But we are called to live out our church membership, to fulfill our church vows. And that's more than being **present, but not participating.**

Some can't be physically present due to moving away or job demands or health problems. But they can, and often are, an active part of the church. They participate by keeping up with the church folks, calling people for the church, being part of a prayer-chain and yes, by their giving. Even though they can't come, they are present **BY** their participation. Are you participating with your prayers, presence, gifts and service? To be part of the United Methodist Church, at some point, you said yes to that question which said that you wanted to be an active part. How about it?
